After clicking 'Sign Up' you will be taken back to the main website with the members area accessible

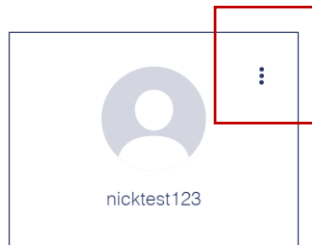
